Business Opportunities in Carbon Markets in EU, Asia and South America

The basic objective of SETatWork is to assist EU ETS industries to increase energy efficiency (EE) and rational use of energy (RUE) through training and project facilitation. SETatWork also aims to facilitate entry of European know-how on Sustainable Energy Technologies (SET) into emerging climate markets: the European Union Emission Trading Scheme (EU ETS) and the Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) market in Asia and South America.

SETatWork Intervention on EU ETS and CDM Markets

The EU ETS market has been put in place as a vehicle for realisation of the EU's commitment to the challenge of reducing the global greenhouse effect. The EU ETS gives European companies the incentive to reduce their CO₂ emissions in a manner that encourages the most cost-effective measures. The CDM is a project based means of meeting the climate goals. The EU Linking Directive allows European companies to act in international CDM markets in accordance with the internationally agreed procedures for CDM projects and to transfer the CO₂ credits gained into the EU ETS scheme.

Focus Areas

Against this background, the aim of SETatWork is to promote the use of sustainable energy technologies/ RTD at the following focus areas in Europe (EU27, EFTA and candidate countries) and Asia (China, Thailand, Malaysia and India):

- **Encourage** companies operating in the EU ETS to use advanced SET solutions for EE and RUE
- **Provide** training on RUE, SET & the Carbon Markets to energy-dependent industries
- **Develop** energy efficiency, energy saving and SET implementation concepts
- **Identify** SET needs for sustainable energy development in Asia and South America, including possibilities for bringing EU know-how into the market
- **Facilitate** SET/CDM projects & financial concepts for faster implementation of RUE
- **Initiate** business cooperation between companies in Asia, South America and EU and strengthen business relations between these regions
