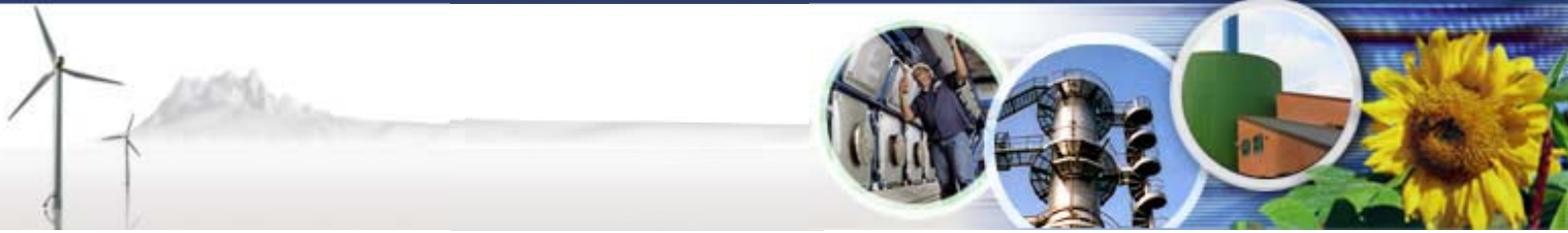

T@W: Point of Departure

- EU's Emission Trading Scheme (ETS) Directive following EU's target on 8% CO₂ reduction
⇒ Companies in EU are to operate on ETS markets and are encouraged to uptake sustainable energy technologies
- EU Linking Directive in relation to the JI and CDM project mechanism
⇒ Companies in EU are able to achieve CO₂ credits via JI and CDM projects in Asia and Russia, thereby boosting a market for sustainable energy technologies



T@W: Objectives

- The key objective is to assist companies in the EU to meet the challenge of climate change
- The action is to help promote specific project development in co-operation with industries and concepts for technology implementation, incl. using research results of EU's Framework Programme
- Part of the action is to develop cooperation with Asia and initiate joint action on research & business, including climate projects (CDM)

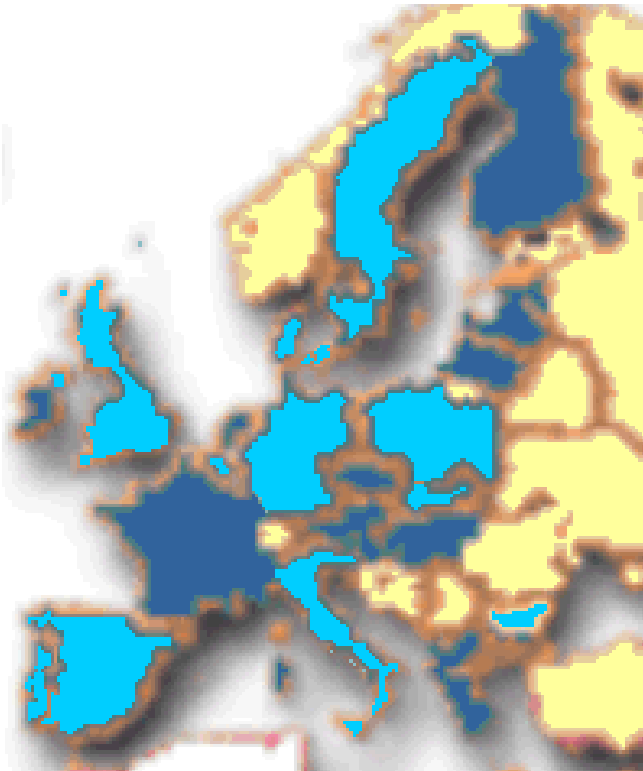

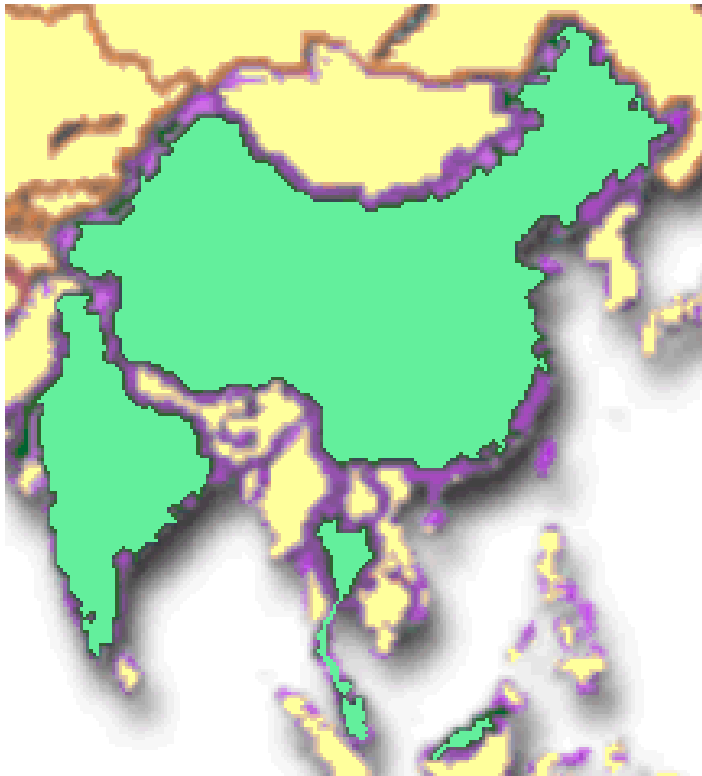

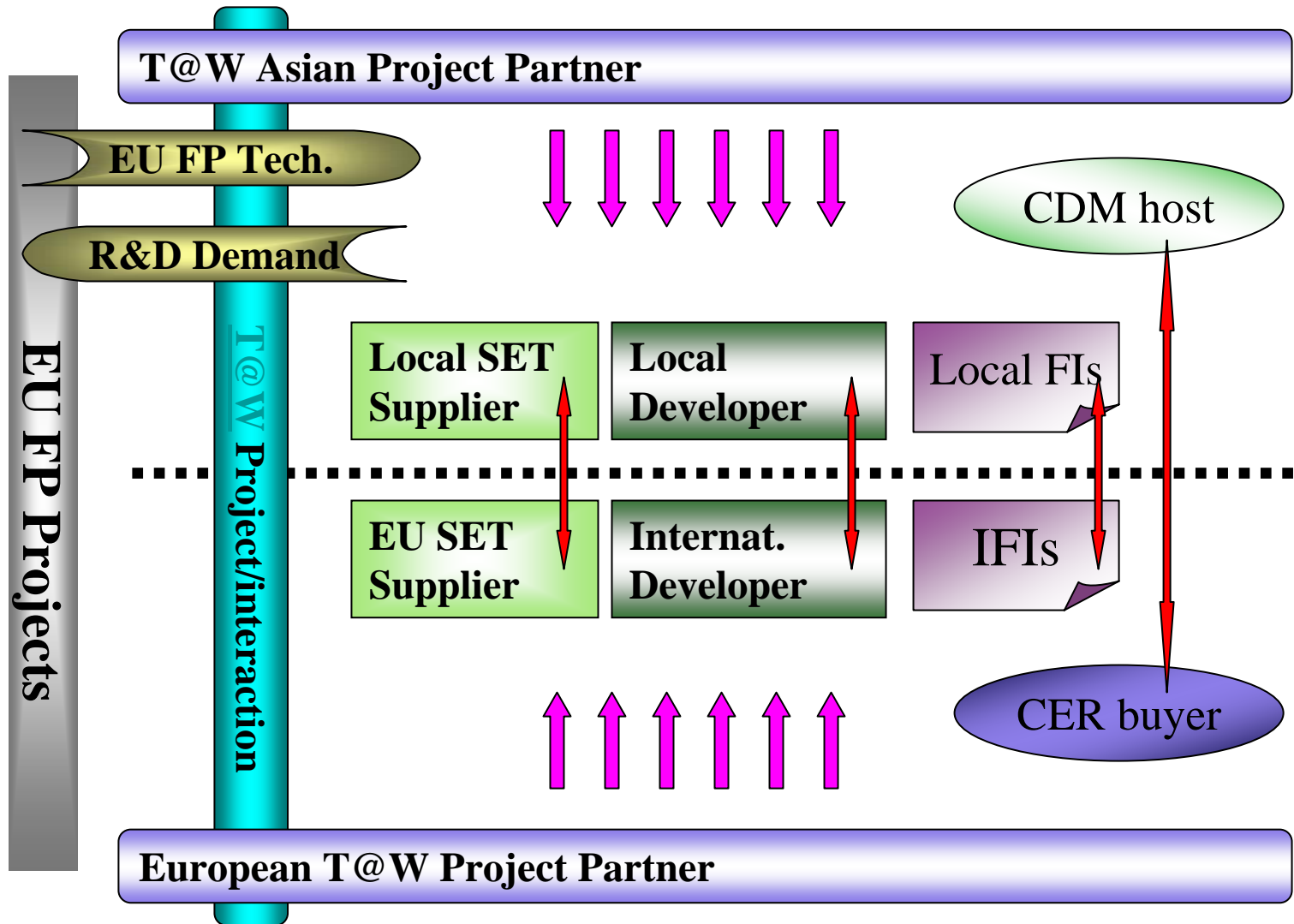

State of activities in Asia

- T@W has made situation analysis, including research and business needs
- A number of CDM projects have been identified in China, Malaysia, Thailand and Asia
- Final part of T@W is to facilitate match-making between market actors in Asia and EU
- The key means are the Facilitation Workshops in Asia
- Further cooperation will be made in relation to Point Carbon event in Copenhagen/Denmark, 10-14 March



Future activities – T@W2

- The European Commission will support a new project period - T@W 2
- The new project is expected to run from spring 2008 and the coming two years
- T@W 2 will put focus on energy efficiency, including promotion of concepts like Programmatic CDM
- European industry participate directly in T@W 2 and is much dedicated to the topic
- GIEC and ZERI are also partners in T@W 2, and entails a chance strengthening contacts between China and EU
